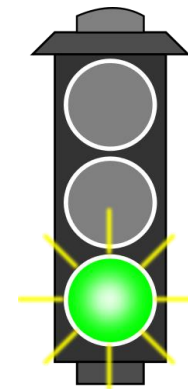
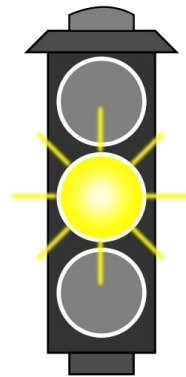
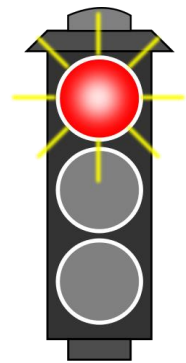

Stoplight Campaign at Euclid Hospital



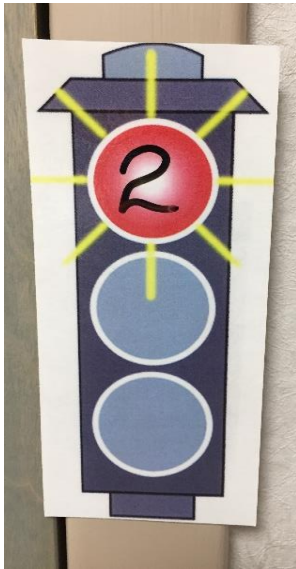

A stop Light will be posted outside each patient door frame to indicate patient needs for mobility and fall prevention.



- This is a visual indicator for all hospital employees to help keep patients safe

Stop lights will let staff know

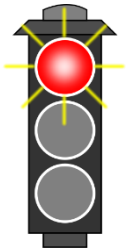
- If the patient can be left alone when up to the bathroom or bedside commode

AND

- How many care givers are needed to help ambulate or transfer the patient.

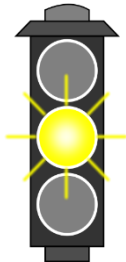
The Color of the Light

- The **color of the light** lets you know if the patient can be left alone



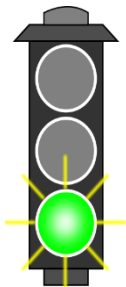
RED LIGHT

Patient cannot be left alone when up to the bathroom or bedside commode out of bed.



YELLOW LIGHT

Patient needs assistance when up to the bathroom or bedside commode and caregiver needs to be nearby



GREEN LIGHT

Patient is steady enough to get up on their own

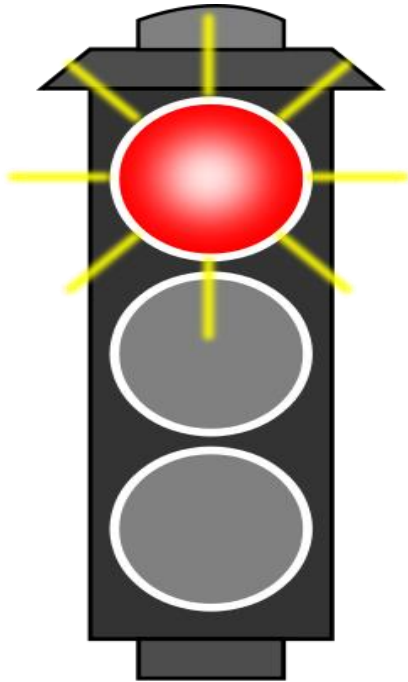
Automatic Red Light Patients

Patients that are impulsive/confused

High fall risk

Hypotensive

Physical Therapy recommendation



The Number on the Light

The number in the light

tells you how many caregivers are needed to get the patient Out of Bed

Points are given to the patient to help determine the assist status

2 or more of the below will be a 2 person assist / 1 below requires 1 person assist

Age over 75

Impulsive/Cognitive impairment

Prior fall within this admission or 48 hours of admission

Procedure within 24 hours that required sedation

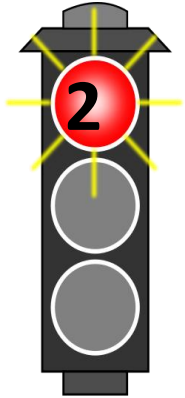
Head injury

Morse Score of 50 or above

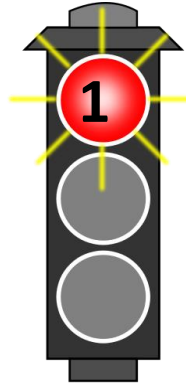
Blood pressure medication adjustment

Physical therapy recommendation

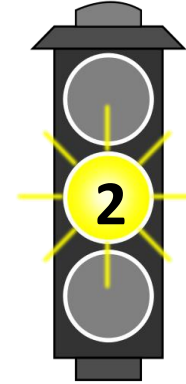
The number is written in dry erase marker on the appropriate color of the stoplight



Patient **needs 2 caregivers** to assist with getting up **and cannot** be left alone when in bathroom or bedside commode



Patient **needs 1 caregiver** to assist when getting up and **cannot** be left alone when in the bathroom or bedside commode



Patient **needs 1 caregiver** to assist when getting up and caregiver **needs to be nearby** when patient is in bathroom or up to BSC.

The stoplight color and number is to be reviewed daily during bedside report and changed as needed.
