In a report issued by The National Academies of Science, Engineering and Medicine, *Improving Diagnosis in Health Care*, diagnostic error has been defined as a failure to:

- a) establish an accurate and timely explanation of the patient's problem(s); or
- b) communicate that explanation to the patient.
